Experience in sensory integration and feeding disorders a plus. We are seeking an individual licensed by the state of Virginia Board of Occupational Therapy. In addition, the therapist must become certified as an early intervention professional by the state of Virginia in the first month of employment. Duties include provision of direct services to infants and toddlers and their families in their home or community environments; and provision of assessments in the home or in one of four centers across the county. Must be able to drive to homes for visits.
