Pre-employment drug testing and FBI criminal background check required.

Coordinates services with other community organizations and medical practitioners, provides services in the natural environment, obtains social and medical background information, develops and reviews individual family service plans (IFSP), assists families in identifying and accessing needed services, initiates activities necessary for child's transition to pre-school services, and completes accurate and timely documentation.
