### VIRGINIA RECEIVES HIGHEST DETERMINATION RATING

Each state must submit to the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP), a State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR) that specifies our annual performance on a set of federally required indicators. Based on that report and other available data, OSEP determines the extent to which the state meets the requirements of Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Virginia has been determined to meet requirements, the highest rating available, for 2017-2018.



This is the third straight year that we have received a determination of "Meets Requirements." This rating reflects tremendous time, effort and teamwork on the part of everyone who is part of the early intervention system in Virginia. Thank you and congratulations to all!
