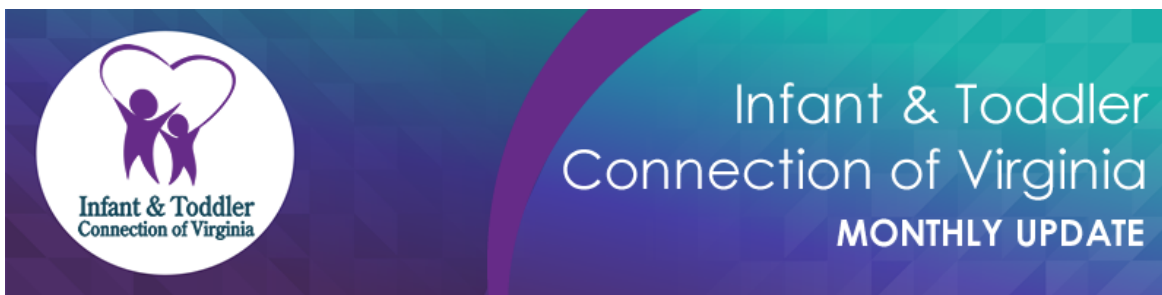

STATE SYSTEMIC IMPROVEMENT PLAN (SSIP)

With April comes the start of our third year of SSIP implementation. A number of activities that started last year are continuing, including work on fidelity assessment, an enhanced statewide data system, and development of a local system manager handbook and orientation. There will also be a number of new activities starting this year. We want and need you to stay engaged with us as we continue our SSIP work. PROVIDER IMPLEMENTATION SURVEY REPORT

The second annual Provider Implementation Survey was conducted in October - November 2017. Service providers, service coordinators, local system managers and administrators completed the survey to assess how functional assessment, the child outcome rating process, coaching and natural learning environment practices are being implemented in Virginia. A written report of statewide results from this survey is now available and has or soon will be posted to the SSIP section of our website at <http://www.infantva.org/Sup-SSIP.htm>.

We encourage you to review this report in order to understand the data from this year's survey and to compare the 2017 report to the baseline data from 2016 (available in the same section of our website). Survey data will be used over time to help evaluate our statewide improvement efforts and identify resources and supports needed in order to implement evidence-based practices.
