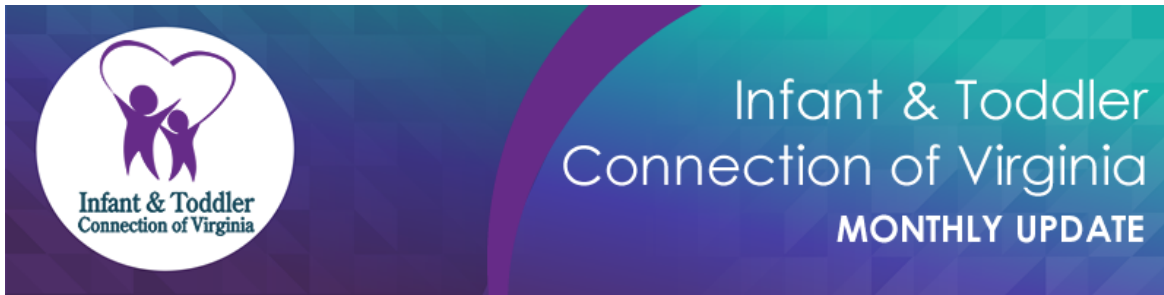

**VCU TRAINING FOR EDUCATORS AND PHYSICAL THERAPISTS**

**Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) Project Will Train Educators and Physical Therapists How to More Effectively Serve Young Children with Significant Disabilities**

VCU researchers and teacher educators have received a \$1.09 million grant to train early childhood special education and physical therapy professionals how to more effectively address the needs of children with significant disabilities. The five-year grant, "Project 3IP: Interdisciplinary and Intensive Intervention Preparation for Professionals Serving Young Children with Significant Disabilities," was awarded by the Office of Special Education Programs in the U.S. Department of Education.

The CCC Plus Contact List includes a designated Fax Number for receipt of IFSPs. *In order to begin communication and collaboration with Care Coordinators and to provide the documentation necessary to facilitate payment of claims, it is highly recommended that the Local System fax the IFSP to the IFSP fax number listed for the MCO in which the child is enrolled as soon as they become aware the child is enrolled in the MCO.*
