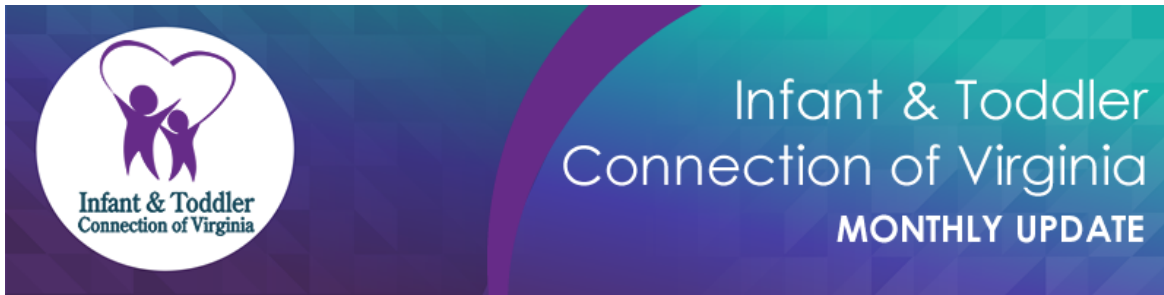

### PROVIDER IMPLEMENTATION SURVEY COMING SOON!

As part of our State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP), Virginia is implementing an annual Provider Implementation Survey. **The second annual survey is coming October 16, 2017.** By completing the survey, you will help the Infant & Toddler Connection of Virginia:

- Understand how evidence-based practices are being used in Virginia;

- Ensure you have the resources and supports you need to implement these practices; and
- Evaluate our statewide improvement efforts to improve outcomes for infants, toddlers and their families.

Higher provider participation will yield more complete and helpful data for use at the state and local level, allowing us to invest future time and effort into activities and supports that providers find helpful and set aside any that are not effective. In order to emphasize the value of provider participation in this survey, those who complete the survey will receive **½-hour of professional development credit** toward the 30 hours required for renewing your early intervention certification.

**All survey responses are confidential** and no information that could identify you will be linked to your individual responses or shared publicly or with any directors, supervisors, the local system manager, or other personnel in your local early intervention system or your program/agency.

### PRACTICE MANUAL REVISIONS:
