XV. POLICIES FOR CONTRACTING OR OTHERWISE ARRANGING FOR SERVICES

A. POLICY

- 1. The <u>State</u> Lead Agency (DMHMRSAS) has a policy in effect pertaining to contracting or making other arrangements with public or private service providers to provide early intervention <u>supports</u> and <u>services</u>. The policy includes:
 - a. A requirement that all early intervention supports and services must meet Virginia standards and be consistent with the provisions of this part;
 - b. The mechanisms that the <u>State</u> Lead Agency uses in arranging for these <u>supports and</u> services, including the process by which awards or other arrangements are made; and
 - c. The basic requirements that must be met by any individual or organization seeking to provide these supports and services for the State Lead Agency. (34 CFR 303.526)
- 2. The <u>State</u> Lead Agency ensures that when arranging for services, the State Procurement Act (available <u>at www.eva.state.va.us)</u> is followed.

B. PROCEDURES

- The <u>State</u> Lead Agency contracts in accordance with the State Procurement Act with <u>Jocal</u> <u>lead agencies</u> (which <u>are</u> required to be public agencies) to carry out and implement early intervention <u>supports and</u> services in accordance with Part C requirements.
- 2. The local <u>lead agency</u> follows local agency procurement procedures that comply with the State Procurement Act when contracting for <u>supports and</u> services.
- Local contracts, as well as local interagency agreements and/or local memoranda of understanding, are used by local <u>lead agencies</u> to <u>require that</u> all local participating agencies/providers <u>comply with Virginia's Part C Policies and Procedures when providing</u> early intervention <u>supports and</u> services.
