Subj: Draft SPP/APR

In December 2005, Virginia submitted its State Performance Plan (SPP) to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) in accordance with federal requirements in the 2004 Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act. That 2004 statute also requires states to annually report on state and local status with regard to the targets set for each of the indicators in the SPP. The first Annual Performance Report (APR) is due to the Office of Special Education Programs on February 1, 2007. Along with the APR, States must submit a revised SPP reflecting baseline data for Indicator 4 (family outcomes), updated information about the child outcome measurement system associated with Indicator 3, and changes in improvement activities. Please find attached the draft revisions to the State Performance Plan and the draft Annual Performance Report. Revisions in the attached SPP are indicated in blue font.

Both documents were drafted based on initial input from the Virginia Interagency Coordinating Council (VICC). These documents are now available for review and comment by any interested stakeholders through January 4, 2007. Written comments may be submitted to:
