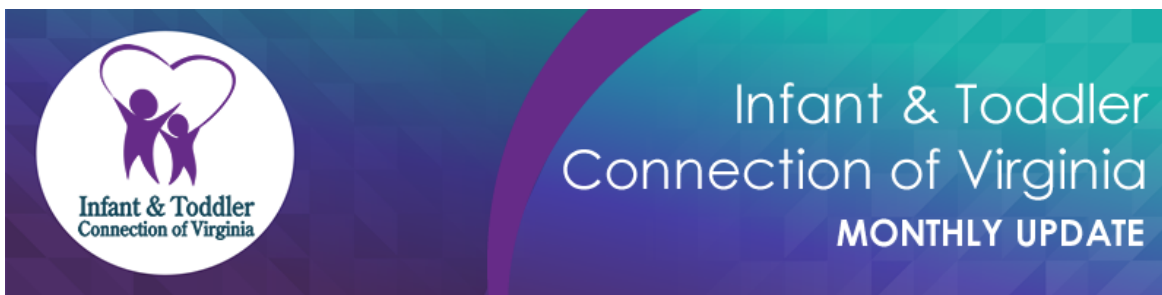

#### STATE SYSTEMIC IMPROVEMENT PLAN (SSIP)

We have completed our third year of SSIP implementation and recently submitted our required report to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP). This SSIP report has or will soon be posted to our website and includes an update on our implementation of SSIP activities, evaluation results, outputs accomplished and next steps. #### PROVIDER IMPLEMENTATION SURVEY REPORT

The third annual Provider Implementation Survey was conducted in November 2018. Service providers, service coordinators, local system managers and administrators completed the survey to

assess how functional assessment, the child outcome rating process, coaching and natural learning environment practices are being implemented in Virginia. A written report of statewide results from this survey is now available and has or soon will be posted under the SSIP Evaluation header in the SSIP section of our website at <http://www.infantva.org/Sup-SSIP.htm>. We encourage you to review this report in order to understand the trends in local infrastructure development and use of evidence-based practices over time. This survey data provides valuable information for evaluating our statewide improvement efforts and identifying resources and supports needed in order to implement evidence-based practices. Each local system also receives a report with local data for use in further improvement planning. If you'd like to see the results for the local system with which you work, you can ask your Local System Manager.

## COACHING FIDELITY ASSESSMENT SUMMARY

On October 1, 2017, Virginia implemented statewide requirements for fidelity assessment related to coaching practices. In December, 2018, all local systems submitted reports on the results of fidelity observations completed in the first year of fidelity assessment implementation. A statewide Coaching Fidelity Assessment Summary report has been developed to summarize the fidelity data reported by local systems.
